

SPECIAL MEETING

City of Marysville, Marysville, Kansas, December 20, 2021

Members of the Governing Body of the City of Marysville were called to order in a special meeting at 5:30 p.m., on the date and at the place noted above with Mayor Barnes opening the meeting. City Clerk Holle and City Administrator St. John were also present.

Council members answering present to roll call were: Frye, Keating, Snellings, Beikman, Goracke, Behrens and Throm. CM Price was absent. A quorum was present. The call, signed by seven of seven council members present, read as follows:

We, the undersigned councilmembers of the City of Marysville hereby respectfully request that you call a special council meeting of the members of the governing body of said City to be held at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, December 20, 2021, at City Hall for the following purpose:

Discuss matters of non-elected personnel not general personnel policies and interview police chief candidates.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 5:31 p.m. CM Throm moved, CM Frye seconded to recess in executive session to discuss personnel matters of non-elected personnel, discussion on specific personnel matters, not general personnel policies, exception K.S.A. 75-4319 (b) (1). This session will include the mayor, city council and the city administrator as well as the interviewees. The open meeting will resume in the city council chamber at 8:30 p.m. Motion carried unanimously. At 6:30 p.m. CM Frye left the council chamber. At 7:15 p.m. CM Frye returned to the council chamber. At 8:30 p.m. council reconvened. Mayor Barnes reported no action was taken during the executive session and the regular session was continuing.
